1) Obedience

- Obedience is the starting point when it comes to kingdom harvest.
- Obedience is a qualifier for harvest and a principle clearly stated in the word of God and should be fully embraced.
- Obedience to the truth that our cooperation is needed in the harvest process.
- Obedience to the truth that harvest is a kingdom principle.
- Obedience in harvest will mean harvesting where He says you should harvest; when He says it; how He says it should be done and what He says you should harvest.

* This will require your ability to hear from Him and talk with Him.
