- Obstacles to authority to govern were nailed to the cross



Communion – The Blood Isaiah 9:7 NKJV

⁷Of the increase of *His* government and peace *There will* be no end, Upon the throne of David and over His kingdom, To order it and establish it with judgment and justice From that time forward, even forever.

The zeal of the LORD of hosts will perform this.

Protect and Empower: Nehemiah 4:13-14 AMP

¹³ So I set [armed men] behind the wall in places where it was least protected; I even thus used the people as families with their swords, spears, and bows.

¹⁴I looked [them over] and rose up and said to the nobles and officials and the other people, Do not be afraid of the enemy; [earnestly] remember the Lord and imprint Him [on your minds], great and terrible, and [take from Him courage to] fight for your brethren, your sons, your daughters, your wives, and your homes.



Not Self-Serving: 1 Samuel 8:3-5 NIV

³ But his sons did not follow his ways. They turned aside after dishonest gain and accepted bribes and perverted justice.

⁴ So all the elders of Israel gathered together and came to Samuel at Ramah.

⁵They said to him, "You are old, and your sons do not follow your ways; now appoint a king to lead us, such as all the other nations have."



Voice of the less fortunate: Proverbs 31:8-9 NLT

⁸ Speak up for those who cannot speak for themselves; ensure justice for those being crushed.

⁹Yes, speak up for the poor and helpless, and see that they get justice.

Responsibility to protect: Genesis 4:9 KJV

⁹ And the LORD said unto Cain, Where is Abel thy brother? And he said, I know not: Am I my brother's keeper?



Punish lawbreakers: 1 Peter 2:14 TPT

14 or the governors he puts in place to punish lawbreakers and to praise those who do what's right.

Romans 13:4 TPT

⁴Those in authority are God's servants for the good of society. But if you break the law, you have reason to be alarmed, for they are God's agents of punishment to bring criminals to justice. Why do you think they carry weapons?



Self-Government: Live according to the word of God

Ecclesiastes 12:13-14 NIV

¹³ Now all has been heard; here is the conclusion of the matter: Fear God and keep his commandments, for this is the duty of all mankind.

¹⁴ For God will bring every deed into judgment, including every hidden thing, whether it is good or evil.



Family Government: The story of a nation reflects the stories of its families written in bold print.

Ephesians 5:21-23 NKJV

- ²¹ submitting to one another in the fear of God.
- ²² Wives, submit to your own husbands, as to the Lord.
- ²³ For the husband is head of the wife, as also Christ is head of the church; and He is the Savior of the body.
- Parents are head over their children (Ephesians 6:1)



Church Government: To provide a moral compass to the nation through the exemplary lives of members.

Proverbs 13:13-14 AMP

¹³ Whoever despises the word *and* counsel [of God] brings destruction upon himself, But he who [reverently] fears *and* respects the commandment [of God] will be rewarded.

¹⁴ The teaching of the wise is a fountain *and* source of life, So that one may avoid the snares of death.



Civil Government: In place to provide a just environment where personal and collective freedoms are upheld and protected.

- Civil government is not a moral government
- Civil statutes define and legislate crime not sin
- Not obligated to enforce the commands of God
- Enforce moral precepts such as murder, theft, perjury, etc., as violations of civil relations
- Christians owe Caesar only what is civil



Dominion: Genesis 1:28 NLT

²⁸ Then God blessed them, and God said to them, "Be fruitful and multiply; fill the earth and subdue it; have dominion over the fish of the sea, over the birds of the air, and over every living thing that moves on the earth."

- Dominion over creatures
- Dominion is also living out your faith in every area of life
- Christians are not to impose Christianity on others but to live as salt of the earth and light of the world (Matthew 5:13-16)



Submission: Romans 13:1-2 NIV

- ¹Let everyone be subject to the governing authorities, for there is no authority except that which God has established. The authorities that exist have been established by God.
- ² Consequently, whoever rebels against the authority is rebelling against what God has instituted, and those who do so will bring judgment on themselves.
- You disobey only when governing authorities ask you to sin (Acts 5:27-29)
- Lead as servant leaders and don't lord it over your people (Mark 10:42)



Prayer: 1 Timothy 2:1-4 NLT

- ¹I urge you, first of all, to pray for all people. Ask God to help them; intercede on their behalf, and give thanks for them.
- ² Pray this way for kings and all who are in authority so that we can live peaceful and quiet lives marked by godliness and dignity.
- ³This is good and pleases God our Savior,
- ⁴ who wants everyone to be saved and to understand the truth.



Preaching: Acts 24:24-25 NKJV

²⁴ And after some days, when Felix came with his wife Drusilla, who was Jewish, he sent for Paul and heard him concerning the faith in Christ.

²⁵ Now as he reasoned about righteousness, self-control, and the judgment to come, Felix was afraid and answered, "Go away for now; when I have a convenient time I will call for you."

- Paul did not change the message to please the governor



Participate by Staying on God's Side

Commander of the Lord's Army: Joshua 5:13-14 NKJV

¹³ And it came to pass, when Joshua was by Jericho, that he lifted his eyes and looked, and behold, a Man stood opposite him with His sword drawn in His hand. And Joshua went to Him and said to Him, "Are You for us or for our adversaries?"

¹⁴ So He said, "No, but as Commander of the army of the LORD I have now come." And Joshua fell on his face to the earth and worshiped, and said to Him, "What does my Lord say to His servant?"



Participate by Staying on God's Side

Commander of the Lord's Army: Joshua 5:13-14 NKJV

- God has no favorites
- The Commander came to take over but not to take sides
- God has not given His allegiance to any party
- No permanent friends but permanent interests
- Win some, lose some, but God's agenda prevails The case of Ai
- Christians should run for public office



Participate when you have the resume - King David

Psalm 89:20-24 NKJV

- ²⁰ I have found My servant David; With My holy oil I have anointed him,
- ²¹ With whom My hand shall be established; Also My arm shall strengthen him.
- ²² The enemy shall not outwit him, Nor the son of wickedness afflict him.
- ²³ I will beat down his foes before his face, And plague those who hate him.
- ²⁴ "But My faithfulness and My mercy *shall be* with him, And in My name his horn shall be exalted.



Participate when you have the resume - King David

- David, a man after God's own heart, would do anything God asked him to do (Acts 13:22)
- Fighting Goliath was a demonstration of absolute faith in God (1 Samuel 17)
- David loved God's law (Psalm 119:47-48)
- David always thanked the Lord for everything (Psalm 100:4)
- He was truly repentant after his sin with Bathsheba (Psalm 51)
- Christians should strive to be like the imperfect David!

- You must be able to walk and chew gum
- Walk the walk and talk the talk
- Encourager of healthy conflicts on The Hill
- Favorable time in perspective of the nation's history

- Veteran or other selfless service contrast the sons of Eli
