Matthew 26:14-16 (NIV)

Judas Agrees to Betray Jesus

14 Then one of the Twelve—the one called Judas Iscariot—went to the chief priests

15 and asked, “What are you willing to give me if I deliver him over to you?”
So they counted out for him thirty pieces of silver.

16 From then on Judas watched for an opportunity to hand him over.

The Body of Jesus Christ Betrayed

1 Corinthians 11:23 (AMPC)

²³ For I received from the Lord Himself that which I passed on to you [it was given to me personally], that the Lord Jesus on the night when He was treacherously delivered up *and* while His betrayal was in progress took bread,

²⁴ And when He had given thanks, He broke [it] and said, *Take, eat*. This is My body, which is broken for you. Do this to call Me [affectionately] to remembrance.

Betrayal will cause...

- Mental anguish
- Discouragement
- Hurt
- Feelings of pain
- Weeping
- Etc.

IF...

- You had been betrayed...
 - Are being betrayed...
 - Will be betrayed...

- ✓ Adopt the attitude of Jesus - TAKE BREAD!!!
 - ✓ Replace the painful memory of betrayal by calling Jesus affectionately to remembrance.

Matthew 27:1-10 (NIV)

Judas Hangs Himself

1 Early in the morning, all the chief priests and the elders of the people made their plans how to have Jesus executed.

2 So they bound him, led him away and handed him over to Pilate the governor.

3 When Judas, who had betrayed him, saw that Jesus was condemned, he was seized with remorse and returned the thirty pieces of silver to the chief priests and the elders.

4 “I have sinned,” he said, “for I have betrayed innocent blood.” “What is that to us?” they replied. “That’s your responsibility.”

5 So Judas threw the money into the temple and left. Then he went away and hanged himself.

6 The chief priests picked up the coins and said, “It is against the law to put this into the treasury, since it is blood money.”

7 So they decided to use the money to buy the potter’s field as a burial place for foreigners.

8 That is why it has been called the Field of Blood to this day.

9 Then what was spoken by Jeremiah the prophet was fulfilled: “They took the thirty pieces of silver, the price set on him by the people of Israel,

10 and they used them to buy the potter’s field, as the Lord commanded me.”

The Blood of Jesus Christ

1 Corinthians 11:25 (AMPC)

25 Similarly when supper was ended, He took the cup also, saying, This cup is the new covenant [ratified and established] in My blood. Do this, as often as you drink [it], to call Me [affectionately] to remembrance.
