Genesis 3:15 (AMP)

a) We only receive our harvest in heaven

We also harvest on earth. While the earth remains...

Genesis 8:22 (NKJV)

“While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease.”

b) Kingdom harvest can be done at any time

❑ Harvest is a season; therefore, kingdom harvest is seasonal.

Ecclesiastes 3:2a (NLT)

A time to plant and a time to harvest.

Proverbs 10:4-5 (NIV)

“Lazy hands make for poverty, but diligent hands bring wealth. He who gathers crops in summer is a prudent son, but he who sleeps during harvest is a disgraceful son”.

c) You do not need to sow after harvest

- ❑ Seed and harvest is a continuous process. He gives seed to the sower and bread to the eater.

2 Corinthians 9:10 (NIV)

Now he who supplies seed to the sower and bread for food will also supply and increase your store of seed and will enlarge the harvest of your righteousness.

- ❑ The harvest process provides you with more opportunities to have seed to sow. Never stop sowing and never stop harvesting. Do it for as long as the earth remains.

Galatians 6:9 (KJV)

And let us not be weary in well doing: for in due season we shall reap, if we faint not.

d) You will reap (harvest) a hundredfold when you sow

- Many factors come into play after sowing in order to guarantee a hundredfold return.
- That is why there is something known as the 100fold, 60fold, and 30fold produce, when it comes to harvest (Matthew 13:23).
- It is therefore possible to get no fold when you sow.

Micah 6:15 (NIV)

15 You will plant but not harvest; you will press olives but not use the oil, you will crush grapes but not drink the wine.

A hundredfold

- A hundredfold is not necessarily 100 times return of the original seed planted
- It is simply the greatest possible return on any particular seed sown.
- For example, a hundredfold return on a grapefruit seed would be a strong, healthy tree that produces an abundance of high quality grapefruit every year.
- When we believe God for the hundredfold return in our lives, we believe for the greatest possible return on every seed we sow!

e) Kingdom harvest is automatic

Kingdom harvest is not automatic. God requires our cooperation. Harvest is man's responsibility.

James 5:4 (NIV)

Look! The **wages** you failed to pay the workers who mowed your fields are **crying out** against you.

The **cries** of **the harvesters** have reached the ears of the Lord Almighty.

Both the harvests and the harvesters cry out.

Both need relieve.

Solution #1;

Revelation 14:18 (NIV) – Call on the angel

18 Still another **angel**, who had charge of the fire, came from the altar and called in a loud voice to him who had the sharp sickle, "Take your sharp sickle and gather the clusters of grapes from the earth's vine, because its grapes are ripe."

Solution #2;

James 5:4 – We need to call on

- the Lord of Hosts (ESV);
- the Lord of heavens armies (NLT);
- the Lord of Saboath (NKJV).

Solution #3;

Another way to guarantee our harvest is by speaking the word of God over our seeds. The words of our mouth is very important when it comes to our harvest. Understand what the word has to say concerning your harvest, declare the word and make confessions in line with the word.

1 Corinthians 3:6 (NIV)

☐ Genesis 8:22 (NKJV) - “While the earth remains, seedtime and harvest, cold and heat, winter and summer, and day and night shall not cease.”

Therefore, I sow my seeds in faith knowing that the principle of seed and harvest is working on my behalf/for me. Seed! Bring forth a harvest. I am expecting a harvest.

☐ Genesis 1:11 NKJV - Then God said, “Let the earth bring forth grass, the herb that yields seed, and the fruit tree that yields fruit according to its kind, whose seed is in itself, on the earth”; and it was so.

Therefore, I have sown seeds (souls, financial, time, righteousness, etc.) and I am expecting them to produce after its own kind in the form of blessings/harvest.

☐ Mark 4:26-27 (NKJV) - And He said, "The kingdom of God is as if a man should scatter seed on the ground, and should sleep by night and rise by day, and the seed should sprout and grow, he himself does not know how.

Therefore, I am expecting every seed that I have sown to grow up, to spring up and to produce an abundant harvest.

☐ Job 36:11 (NKJV) - If they obey and serve Him, They shall spend their days in prosperity, And their years in pleasures.

Therefore, because I have been obedient to God and have sown my seeds, I expect my days to be filled with prosperity and my years with pleasure.

□ Psalm 115:12 and 14 (NKJV) - The LORD has been mindful of us; He will bless us; He will bless the house of Israel; He will bless the house of Aaron. May the LORD give you increase more and more, You and your children.

Therefore, because God has seen my sowing His mind is continually on me, I am expecting more and more blessings (souls, financial, righteousness, restoration) and more and more increase to come into my life and into the life of my children.

□ Luke 6:38 (NKJV) - Give, and it will be given to you: good measure, pressed down, shaken together, and running over will be put into your bosom. For with the same measure that you use, it will be measured back to you.”

Therefore, I am expecting good measure, pressed down and shaken together and running over harvest from every seed that I have sown.

☐ 2 Corinthians 9:6 (NKJV) - But this I say: He who sows sparingly will also reap sparingly, and he who sows bountifully will also reap bountifully.

Therefore, I am expecting a bountiful harvest because I am a bountiful sower.

☐ 2 Corinthians 9:8 NKJV - And God is able to make all grace abound toward you, that you, always having all sufficiency in all things, may have an abundance for every good work.

Therefore, I am expecting to have all sufficiency, more than enough, abounding in every blessing so that I am able to sow into every good work as the Holy spirit impresses upon me.

□ 2 Chronicles 20:20 NKJV - So they rose early in the morning and went out into the Wilderness of Tekoa; and as they went out, Jehoshaphat stood and said, "Hear me, O Judah and you inhabitants of Jerusalem: Believe in the LORD your God, and you shall be established; believe His prophets, and you shall prosper."

Therefore, since I do believe in the Lord my God and I believe what His prophet has spoken about the month of May 2021 being a month of HARVEST, I am expecting HARVEST each day of this month; as the word of God comes to pass in my life. So be it.

□ Isaiah 30:23 NASB - Then He will give you rain for the seed which you will sow in the ground, and bread from the yield of the ground, and it will be rich and plenteous; on that day your livestock will graze in a roomy pasture.

Therefore, because the Lord will give me rain for the seed with which I have sown to the ground, I will reap a rich and plenteous harvest.

□ Jeremiah 31:5 NIV - "Again you will plant vineyards on the hills of Samaria; The planters will plant and will enjoy them.

Therefore, I am a planter (a seed sower) and every seed I plant, I will enjoy the harvest.

☐ **James 3:18 NASB** - And the seed whose fruit is righteousness is sown in peace by those who make peace.

Therefore, I am a peacemaker, I have sown in peace, and I will reap a harvest of righteousness.

☐ **Psalm 126:5-6 NASB** - Those who sow in tears shall reap with joyful shouting. He who goes to and fro weeping, carrying his bag of seed, Shall indeed come again with a shout of joy, bringing his sheaves with him.

Therefore, every seed I sowed sacrificially, I will reap and reap joyfully.

☐ Galatians 6:9 NIV - Let us not lose heart in doing good, for in due time we will reap if we do not grow weary.

Therefore, because I have not grown weary in sowing my seeds and praying for a harvest, I expect to reap a great harvest.
