John 19:30 NKJV

³⁰ So when Jesus had received the sour wine, He said, "It is finished!" And bowing His head, He gave up His spirit.

"It is finished!" is translated from the word "tetelestai," an accounting word in Greek meaning "paid in full."

Walk In Power - Introduction

- The One Who paid the price on our behalf left Himself with us in the person of the Holy Spirit.
- God is Omnipotent and He desires to relate with us.
- Power is a gift from God which when manifested in and through us reveals Who overshadows us.
- The aroma of Christ attracts the power of God
- We will look at two encounters with God's supernatural power and encourage ourselves to accept His invitation to walk in power.

Thy Kingdom Come Walk In Power – Can You Bear The Weight?

- John 16:7,12-13 NKJV
- ⁷ Nevertheless I tell you the truth. It is to your advantage that I go away; for if I do not go away, the Helper will not come to you; but if I depart, I will send Him to you.
- ¹² “I still have many things to say to you, but you cannot bear *them* now.
- ¹³ However, when He, the Spirit of truth, has come, He will guide you into all truth; for He will not speak on His own *authority*, but whatever He hears He will speak; and He will tell you things to come.

Thy Kingdom Come Walk In Power – The Apostolic Ministry

- 2 Corinthians 2:14-16 TPT
- ¹⁴ God always makes his grace visible in Christ, who includes us as partners of his endless triumph. **Through our yielded lives** he spreads the fragrance of the knowledge of God everywhere we go.
- ¹⁵ We have become the **unmistakable aroma *of the victory* of the Anointed One to God**—a perfume of life to those being saved and the odor of death to those who are perishing.
- ¹⁶ The **unbelievers smell a deadly stench** that leads to death, **but believers smell the life-giving aroma** that leads to abundant life. And who of us can rise to this challenge?

Thy Kingdom Come Walk In Power – God Is Omnipotent

- Psalm 115:3 NKJV
- ³ But our God *is* in heaven; He does whatever He pleases.
- Isaiah 55:11 NASB
- ¹¹ So will My word be which goes out of My mouth;
It will not return to Me empty,
Without accomplishing what I desire,
And without succeeding *in the purpose* for which I sent it.

Thy Kingdom Come Walk In Power – God Is Omnipotent

- Jeremiah 32:17 NASB
- ¹⁷ ‘Oh, Lord God! Behold, You Yourself have made the heavens and the earth by Your great power and by Your outstretched arm! Nothing is too difficult for You,
- Matthew 19:26 NKJV
- ²⁶ But Jesus looked at *them* and said to them, “With men this is impossible, but with God all things are possible.”

2 Encounters With God's Supernatural Power

- Genesis 3:8 AMPC
- ⁸ And they heard the sound of the Lord God walking in the garden in the cool of the day, and Adam and his wife hid themselves from the presence of the Lord God among the trees of the garden.
- Genesis 17:3-4 NLT
- ³ At this, Abram fell face down on the ground. Then God said to him, ⁴ "This is my covenant with you: I will make you the father of a multitude of nations!"

Thy Kingdom Come

Invitation and Demonstration of God's Power

- Isaiah 64:1 NKJV
- ¹ Oh, that You would rend the heavens! That You would come down!
That the mountains might shake at Your presence—
- Matthew 27:51-52 NIV
- ⁵¹ At that moment the curtain of the temple was torn in two from top to bottom. The earth shook, the rocks split
- ⁵² and the tombs broke open. The bodies of many holy people who had died were raised to life.

Thy Kingdom Come

Promise and Impartation of God's Power

- John 20:21-22 NKJV
- ²¹ So Jesus said to them again, "Peace to you! As the Father has sent Me, I also send you."
- ²² And when He had said this, He breathed on *them*, and said to them, "Receive the Holy Spirit."
- Luke 24: 49 NLT
- ⁴⁹ "And now I will send the Holy Spirit, just as my Father promised. But stay here in the city until the Holy Spirit comes and fills you with power from heaven."

Thy Kingdom Come

Promise of God's Power

- Acts 1:8 TPT
- ⁸ But I promise you this—the Holy Spirit will come upon you, and **you will be seized with power**. You will be my **messengers** to Jerusalem, throughout Judea, the distant provinces—even to the remotest places on earth!”
- Acts 1:8 AMPC
- ⁸ But you shall receive power (**ability, efficiency, and might**) when the Holy Spirit has come upon you, and you shall be My **witnesses** in Jerusalem and all Judea and Samaria and to the ends (the very bounds) of the earth.

Thy Kingdom Come Peter Walks In God's Power

- Acts 2:41-43 KJV
- ⁴¹ Then they that gladly received his word were baptized: and the same day there were added unto them about three thousand souls.
- ⁴² And they continued stedfastly in the apostles' doctrine and fellowship, and in breaking of bread, and in prayers.
- ⁴³ And fear came upon every soul: and many wonders and signs were done by the apostles.

Thy Kingdom Come

Peter Walked In Authority and Power

- **Authority – Exusiai**
- Judicial authority gained by proximity to the One with supreme authority
- Set captives free from demonic attacks as in deliverance
- Bring about healing as in when demons are cast out of a person
- Removal of affliction, infirmity, diseases, etc.
- Changes the invisible and the visible realms
- Authority is more important than power

Thy Kingdom Come Peter Walked In Authority and Power

- **Power – Dunamis**
- Root word for dynamite
- Gift from God
- Ability to do – turn water into wine, regenerate body parts, cause tumors to disappear, cause implantation
- Changes visible realms
- You need power when praying for someone with deformities
- Power submits to authority

Thy Kingdom Come

Invitation To Walk In Power

- Ephesians 1:18-20 NIV
- ¹⁸ I pray that the eyes of your heart may be enlightened in order that you may know the hope to which he has called you, the riches of his glorious inheritance in his holy people,
- ¹⁹ and his incomparably great power for us who believe. That power is the same as the mighty strength
- ²⁰ he exerted when he raised Christ from the dead and seated him at his right hand in the heavenly realms,

Thy Kingdom Come

Invitation To Walk In Power

- Ephesians 2:6-7 NLT
- ⁶ For he raised us from the dead along with Christ and seated us with him in the heavenly realms because we are united with Christ Jesus.
- ⁷ So God can point to us in all future ages as examples of the incredible wealth of his grace and kindness toward us, as shown in all he has done for us who are united with Christ Jesus.
- 1 John 4:17 KJV
- ¹⁷ Herein is our love made perfect, that we may have boldness in the day of judgment: because as he is, so are we in this world.

Thy Kingdom Come Key To Walking In Power

- 1 Thessalonians 5:16-18 MEV
- ¹⁶ Rejoice always.
- ¹⁷ Pray without ceasing.
- ¹⁸ In everything give thanks, for this is the will of God in Christ Jesus concerning you.
- To have disciplined responses to every level of difficulties, hardships, obstacles, attacks, and challenges that confront you.

Thy Kingdom Come

Walk In Power - Conclusion

- Jesus desires to fully reveal Himself to His people.
- The weightiness of the revelation will crush many of us
- How do you respond to adversities?
- The extent to which we see the power of God made manifest in and through us reveals the extent to which we **respond to adversities with rejoicing, prayer, and giving thanks to God.**
